Anna Lou Snidow, 82, of Mary Ellen's Elder Care, 284 Bailey Hollow Rd. in Princeton, died Monday, March 11, 2013, at her residence. Born July 25, 1930 in Princeton, she was the daughter of the late Waldo Emerson Ballard and Myrtle Ballard.
