Know all Men by these Presents that we Phillip Snidow & Daniel Prilleman are held & firmly bound unto the Commonwealth of Virginia in the just & full sum of Fifty Pounds Consent Money, To which Payment will & Truly to be made we bind our Heirs Executors or Adms. Each of us firmly by these Presents sealed with our seals & dated this 14th day of Feb^r 1782. Whereas there is a Marriage depending & by Gods Permission is only intended between the above bound Phillip Snidow & Barberry Prilleman. Now the Condition of the above obligation is such that if there is no Lawfull Cause to obstruct the said Marriage, Then the above obligation to be void or else to remain in full force Power & Virtue.

Know all men by these presents that we, Philip Snidow & Daniel Prilleman, are held & firmly bound unto the commonwealth of Virginia in the just & full sum of fifty pounds consent money. To which payment will & truly to be made, we bind our heirs, Exec. & adms. Each of them firmly by these presents sealed with our seals and dated this 14th day of Feb. 1782.

Whereas there is a marriage depending & by Gods permission is only intended between the above bound Philip Snidow & Barberry Prilleman. Now the condition of the above obligation is such that if there is no lawful cause to obstruct the said marriage, then the above obligation to be void or else to remain in full force, power and virtue.
